Council has recently become aware of misinformation circulating within our community regarding the RHT Settlement and the Manitoulin Project Claim Settlement. In keeping with this leadership's commitment to open dialogue and transparency, we provide this letter as the first step in addressing the situation directly.

We acknowledge and understand the concerns raised by our members regarding the RHT Settlement and the Manitoulin Project Settlement. These concerns are based on inaccuracies with the facts. Chief & Council is committed to correcting these inaccuracies.

This administration has shared information regarding the RHT/Manitoulin Project throughout this process and will continue to improve our communications to keep members informed. To support in this endeavour, we will be developing a secure "Members Only" platform where documents related to the RHT Settlement and Manitoulin Project Claim can be shared confidentially. Given the complexity of the information, we will also provide summaries and commentary on the documents.

In the meantime, we welcome questions and meaningful dialogue.

Chief & Council will also be hosting an information session for members at the band office on Saturday, May 30, 2026, between 12:00 and 3:00 p.m. At this time, you will have an opportunity to meet one-on-one with our legal and accounting advisors, who will walk you through the PCD/Top Up Form. Chief & Council will also be available to answer any questions you might have regarding the RHT Settlement and the Manitoulin Project Claim Settlement. Off-reserve members who are unable to make it out to the band office may schedule their one-on-one sessions via Zoom.

We appreciate your patience as we get our Members Only platform up and running. In the meantime, we will continue to distribute information through current channels, and during the Saturday session.
